Tom Nairn has been a director of both private and listed manufacturing companies for over twenty-five years, with significant experience of overseas markets and international operations. He is an electrical engineer and has been chief executive of Dale Power Systems Limited and Bray Technologies plc. Previously Chairman of Munster Simms Engineering Ltd. and Eurocare Environmental Services Ltd. Since 2001 he has held four Non-Executive roles with private companies and remains a Non-Executive director of AIM quoted PM Group Plc.

Robert Lowe’s 36 year career has spanned a range of companies principally in the IT sector. Notably he was a director of Micro Focus Group Plc and Superscape PLC being pivotal to the development of both. He has significant international experience and maintains strong business connections.

Mr. Lowe’s last executive role was as CEO of Monaco based Café Grand Prix Sam from which he retired in 2003. Since this time, he has been Non-Executive Chairman of AIM quoted Corpora Plc and a Non-Executive Director of AIM quoted Delling Group PLC.
