Turbotec response to Thermodynamics, Inc. ("Thermodynamics") payment claim

The Company has become aware of the following statement in an announcement of 8 November by Thermodynamics, a majority shareholder in the Company, in relation to Thermodynamics' President and CEO, Robert A Lerman:

"Mr Lerman informed shareholders that due to an ongoing controversy since June with the Turbotec board of directors that could not be resolved through negotiations, Thermodynamics had not been paid the dividend it was due and determined that it would be filing suit in London against Turbotec to collect the sums due. He expressed deep regret that Thermodynamics is forced to resort to the use of the courts."

The Company believes that Mr Lerman's statements, and the Thermodynamics announcement, are inaccurate and potentially misleading, and notified Thermodynamics of this before the statement was released. Negotiations to resolve the relevant dispute were at an advanced stage before the 8 November and Turbotec directors do not believe any additional payment was, or is due to Thermodynamics. Furthermore, the Company has not received notice of any claim to date, and in the event that a claim is received, the Company will vigorously defend it.
